### OVERVIEW

Just over 22 years old, Ayigbe Town, also known as Trassaco, is located in the Otanor electoral area in the Adentan Municipality. There are about 145 structures in the settlement which 4 are used for commercial purposes. The Trassaco Real Estate Company owns the land.

The community does not face any threats of eviction from the company.
