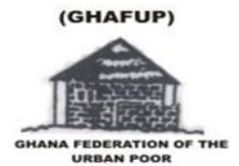


NIGHT MARKET Settlement Profile



OVERVIEW

Originally settled by foreigners, Night Market is a community located within the Tetey Nkpa electoral area of Ashaiman. There are 2,251 structures in the area including 1,921 housing structures. The Tema Development Corporation is the legal custodian of the land.

There has been no threat of eviction.

Community Development Priorities

- Provision of skip containers
- Installation of waste bins
- Provision of household toilet facilities

Education and Health Care

The community has two private nursery schools and one private primary school. The community has two private clinics, which also serve nearby communities. Malaria poses a serious healthcare risk, as does cholera and high teenage pregnancy.

Economic Activities

Artisanship, trading, manufacturing workers, carpenters and chop bars are the major sources of employment available to the economically active individuals. There are only 30 percent of formal workers in the community. The monthly income of community members starts from GHC 60.00.

Governance

The community operates on a two-tier local government system, that is, the elected assembly and unit committee. In addition, there are CBOs operating in the community. Some of these CBOs include WEITA, which is involved with improving welfare development. GHAFUP is also active in micro-financing and community development.
