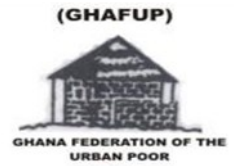


# NSAMANPOM Settlement Profile



## OVERVIEW

Settled in 1992, the community of Nsamapom is located in the Ogbojo electoral area of Adenta. There are 600 structures in the community of which 420 are commercial in nature. The Government of Ghana is the legal custodian of the land, which is being managed by the Adentan Municipal Assembly.

There are ad-hoc threats of eviction by the traditional chiefs of the land.

## Education and Health Care

The community has only one nursery school which is privately owned. There is also one private clinic which also serves nearby communities.

## Economic Activities

Mechanics, Artisanry, trading, and chop bar operation are the major sources of employment available to the economically active individuals living in the community. There are only 10 percent of formal workers and 90% informal workers in the community. The monthly income of community members ranges between GHC 100.00 and GHC 250.00

## Governance

The community operates on a two-tier local government system, that is, the elected assembly member and unit committee. There is also a recognised Council of Elders who gives advice and are consulted on general developmental issues in the community. In addition, there are Community Based Organisations (CBOs) and NGO's operating in the community that help with waste management interventions.
