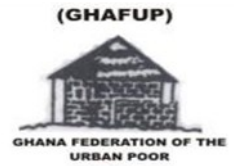


# SRAHA

## Settlement Profile



### OVERVIEW

Sraha is located in Nii Ashale, an electoral area in the Adentan Municipal Assembly. There are 965 structures in the community of which 302 are commercial in nature. The land is legally owned by the Abosu Ayetey Family.

The settlement is known to have gone under some threats of evictions in the past, but there are currently no threats.

### Community Development Priorities

- Construction of a clinic
- Public toilets
- Community Library
- Provision of portable drinking water
- Construction of roads and gutters
- Micro-credit facility

### Education and Health Care

Education and health care services are underdeveloped. The community has two private nursery schools and there is no clinic, health post or hospital.

### Economic Activities

Artisanship, petty trading, food selling, carpentry, hair dressing and sowing/dressmaking are the major sources of employment. Those engaged in formal employment make up about 10% of the workforce. The monthly income of community members ranges between GHC 50.00 and GHC 400.00

### Governance

The community operates on a two-tier local government system, that is, the elected assembly member and a unit committee. There is also a recognised Council of Elders who gives advice and are consulted on general developmental issues in the community. However, there are non recognised CBOs and/or NGOs operating in the community.
