OVERVIEW

Coming to prominence in the 1940s, Tsi Nai Agbe is an electoral area located in Ashaiman. There are about 300 residential structures. Tema Development Corporation and Ashaiman Municipal Assembly are the legal custodians of the land.

Education and Health Care

The community has 17 schools including nursery, primary, JSH and SHS schools. There is one private clinic, which also serves nearby communities.

Economic Activities

Artisanship, trading, manufacturing, carpentry and chop bar operation are the major sources of employment available to the economically active individuals living in the community. There are only 20 percent of formal workers and 80% informal workers in the community. Note that there is a prevalence of Commercial Sex Workers in this community.

Governance

The community operates on a two-tier local government system, that is, the elected assembly member and unit committee. In addition, there are Community Based Organisations (CBOs) operating in the community such as Community Our Concern (OCOC), which is involved in the improvement of their community and GHAFUP, a community led
