OVERVIEW

Over 20 years old, Aben Woha is located in the New Adentan Electoral Area of the Adentan Municipality. There are about 1600 structures in the settlement with close to 4,800 rooms. The State Housing Company owns the land and are the legal custodians.

The settlement does not face any threats of eviction from the State Housing Company.

Community Development Priorities

- Construction of drains

Education and Health Care

The community has five schools ranging from nursery to SHS. One of the nursery/primary schools are government/mission managed. The community also has one private clinic. Malaria, Cholera, and Typhoid are the major health challenge of the community. Currently, there are two doctors and four nurses managing the clinic.

Economic Activities

Artisanship, petty trading, construction and driving are the major sources of employment available to economically active individuals, of which 10% have formal employment. The monthly income of community members ranges from GHC 50.00 – 500.00. About half of the community members are old soldiers and hence rely on their pensions.

Governance

The community operates on a two-tier local government system, that is, the elected assembly member and unit committee. Chiefs and Opinion Leaders are also active in the community. GHAFUP is the only active CBO and is supported by PD.
